

VIRGINIA CLEAN ENERGY JOBS & ECONOMIC IMPACT REPORT



Virginia is a growing clean energy leader, ranking 11th nationwide for clean energy jobs, 10th for electric vehicle registrations, and 11th for installed solar energy. The Old Dominion State has already generated over \$5.7 billion in solar investment and is projected to have the 9th most solar installed in the country within the next five years.

With the economic boon anticipated from the burgeoning offshore wind industry, Virginia is not only well-positioned but also well-diversified to take advantage of the clean energy economy.

It's been a great year for Virginia's clean energy economy, with the state announcing more than \$81 million in clean energy economic investments stemming from strong state-level clean energy leadership and incentives associated with the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) and Inflation Reduction Act (IRA).

Even more encouraging is the clean energy future that Virginia is building. In addition to Virginia's bright solar prospects, the state is poised to become a market leader in offshore wind technology, manufacturing, and deployment. Thanks to two new major offshore wind projects—one proposed and one about to begin construction—Virginia could see an associated \$16 billion in investment and 5,200 jobs.

Highlights of those new investments include:

- \$8.5M and 134 new jobs via Lyon
 Shipyard's expansion to service offshore wind farms, Norfolk
- \$200M investment and 300 jobs via
 Dulles Airport's new solar, battery, and
 EV initiative, Loudon County
- \$1B factory creating 1,700 jobs as LEGO's new solar powered factory goes carbon-neutral, Chesterfield County
